UPDATE ON FINANCES: May 2018

During the month of April, we received \$9,322.15 in pledge money (5 Sundays including Easter). Our total contributed support and pledge income are both just slightly ahead of where they should be with 33% of the year elapsed. We have received 1 additional pledge, which brings our total to 32!

Thus far, we have adhered pretty well to the budget proposed for 2018. We have paid all of the Deanery Assessment, which supports mission, and we have paid 50% of the Diocesan Assessment. Approximately \$3,500 remains to be paid. During the summer, we do not receive rent from the Nursery School, and cash flow tends to slow down. We cannot stress enough the importance of keeping up with pledge contributions. So far, we are doing very well in that regard.

The Finance Committee has been meeting regularly since the beginning of the year and has addressed such matters as making the P&L sheets more transparent, initiating the performance of an audit of church finances, and looking ahead at our finances for the remainder of the year. The committee consists of Paul Atlee, Larry Way, Ann Dailey, Beth Hixon, Robin Wunder (bookkeeper), and Susan Garone. If you have any questions about the committee and its goals, please do not hesitate to speak to any of the members.
