The Vestry will be meeting Wednesday to solidify plans for our move.

THE DREAM OF GOD *for You, for Me, for Epiphany!* As we begin our journey into the unknown future, we will be discerning anew our mission as a Christian Community. On five Sundays in September and October (see Save the Date listing below), we will gather after the 10 am service to prayerfully contemplate and discuss who we are called to be for God in the world. We will ground our work in an excellent five-chapter book, "The Dream of God: A Call to Return by Verna Dozier. (Find it on Amazon for purchase or downloading.) Your participation is vitally important. Please plan to buy and read the book and to attend the gatherings.

EPIPHANY HOPE PROJECTS: As the vestry plans to exit the church building, we will be informing you of ways you can be involved in the many projects and tasks before us. Here are the first two for your consideration: **1) Pews:** By the end of October, all items in the church and the undercroft that are going to be saved, sold, donated or taken away... all must be gone from the building. 2) Invitees to Closing Eucharist: Everyone in our current directory will receive an invitation to the final worship service in the church building which will take place on **Saturday, September 29th**. MID-WEEK PRAYER and PROJECTS: Beginning September 5th, every Wednesday, the 10:15 Holy Eucharist and Bible Study will be offered in thanksgiving for the life of the Church of the Epiphany... our past, our present, and our future. Following the Eucharist, those who wish will enjoy a "brown bag lunch" from 11:30 to 12:00. At noon, we'll work for an hour or two on projects necessary for our move from the church building. FINANCIAL UPDATE- JULY 2018

The ups and downs of summer cash flow are well known to us at Epiphany. During June our cash reserves were dwindling, but the month of July has been a blessing, due to lump sum pledges paid, pledge installments, and even excess pledge paid! We received a total of \$17,409 in pledge income in July, which puts us at 66% of expected for the year, with 58.33% of the year elapsed. We also received a gift from a "Friend of Epiphany" of \$500 to be put toward maintenance of our property. Thanks be to God!
