ANNUAL MEETING TODAY following the 10 am service. Please plan to attend and bring the emailed report with you if you'd like to refer to it. The Vestry will offer short oral summaries of their reports, present a leadership slate for your consideration and approval, and will be glad to hear your questions/concerns.

NEXT SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 2ND, the 10 am service begins with a service of light as we celebrate **The Feast of the Presentation of Our Lord, or Candlemas**. This is technically the end of the celebration of the Nativity of Jesus Christ when the gospel lesson describes his presentation in the temple 40 days after his birth. The Book of Common Prayer prescribes this fixed date feast as taking precedence over the usually appointed Sunday lections and liturgy whenever February 2nd falls on a Sunday. This occurs every 5-11 years... next time in 2025!

COMMUNION ADMINISTRATION: In order to help Eucharistic Ministers who administer the wine, please take the cup from the minister by grasping it with both hands and taking a *sip* from the cup without assistance as you are able. During flu season (and really all the time), if you instinct (dip) your wafer, please be extra cautious about having clean hands and do not allow your fingers to touch the wine. Believe it or not, there is ample scientific evidence to support the fact that dipping spreads more germs than sipping from the common cup. Remember that receiving the host (wafer) only is considered a full communion.

FINANCIAL UPDATE as of December 31, 2019

We received \$6,240 in pledges for December, bringing the yearly total to \$102,242, approximately \$13,000 more than expected. This is truly a testament to the commitment and generosity of our congregation, and gives us good reason to feel hopeful. 30 pledge cards have been turned in for next year, including from 2 new pledgers, and the total pledged is \$103,800. This information is extremely helpful to the Vestry as we go about preparing the budget for next year. Please remember that it is never too late to make a pledge, and that no amount is too small. The act of pledging something, no matter the amount, is a powerful symbol of support and any and all support is appreciated.

The P&L statement for 2019 will be presented at the Annual Meeting along with a full Accounting Warden Report. Please make an effort to attend: it's a great opportunity to get questions answered and see what the future has in store.
